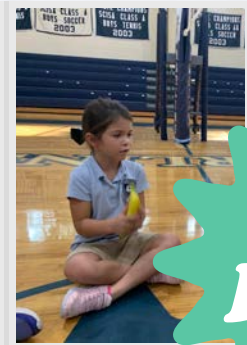
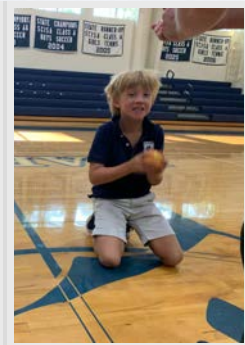

Students in second grade are learning about solfege. Solfege is a musical system used to teach and sing musical notes. It assigns a syllable to each note in a musical scale to make it easier to learn and remember melodies and harmonies. The most common solfege syllables are "Do," "Re," "Mi," "Fa," "Sol," "La," and "Ti."



Students closed their eyes, using only their ears to identify the sounds.

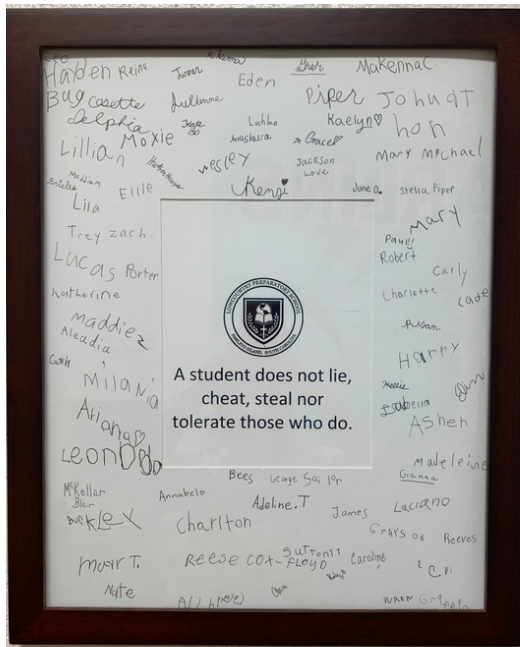


R.E.A.D. Dogs Visit
