- Word Hunt: Look for target words in books of in the newspaper. If using the nowspaper your child can highlight op cipcle the wopd ping words that he/she finds
- SNAP: You put the sight words you want thsm to praction on ilash cards and put the fiash catis inso a jap (maybe life all natmeal jap). Aso you write the word SNAPI on a fow flash capds and put them in the jap also. The fids can play in papthaps of in groups of 3 or 4 . They tale turns pulling a card out of The jars. It they an say the word on the card autonatically with no struggle. they get to keep the capd. If they struggle, they have to put it back. If they pull out one of the capds that says SNAPI They have to purt bace all of the capds they've dpawn.
