At the beginning of class our first day together, I will collect your copy and check for annotations according to the “Annotation Guide Bookmark” I have attached. I suggest printing this on cardstock and indeed using it as a tool to mark your place while reading as well as your guide to annotation. You’ll notice there are three on one page. I suggest printing all three in the event you lose one. The bookmark is the guide I will use when scoring your annotations. When you begin annotating, it will be time consuming. My hope is that as you go, it will become more natural and enlightening. On our first day of class, **be prepared not only to turn in the annotated required reading, but also for any discussion that may arise.**
