****AVANCE** means incorporating advanced grammatical constructions that you know like *le plus-que-parfait*, *le futur*, *l'imparfait*, *le conditionnel*, *le conditionnel passé*, *le subjonctif* in addition to sentences in le présent and le passé composé whenever possible. Remember your sentence starters like *D'après le texte*, *Il s'agit de*, *D'après l'auteur*, *L'article est à propos de...*, etc. It is expected that you are able to use these advanced grammatical structures in class next year.
