- **Quizlet Practice:** Students are expected to practice with vocabulary flashcard sets each week to help prepare them for the upcoming class. They should practice and then test themselves on each of the Quizlet vocabulary lists on our Spanish class Quizlet. Join with this [link](#). No documentation is needed since Mrs. Elliott will be able to log in and see your time spent and “test” scores. The expectation is that students will be able to use and understand these words and phrases so **weekly practice** with them is encouraged for full credit.
